In the light of this idea, the critic goes on to relate women's writing to their bodily experiences that represent a source of desire and urge for creativity.

Born in 1937 in Algeria, Helene Cixous came to Paris, where she is currently professor of English, in 1955. After a dissertation on James Joyce, *The Exile of James Joyce* (1968), she began to publish novels, critical essays, and plays, most notably *Le Portrait de Dora* (1976), a feminist retelling of a Freudian case history.
